SEMINAR OBJECTIVE:

The objective of this seminar will be to review the criteria and minimum information necessary to successfully undertake life safety commissioning within a complex building.

SEMINAR OUTLINE:

The current (and proposed) editions of provincial and federal building and fire Codes now mandate that the life safety systems be commissioned as a whole. Additionally, the 2015 National Building Code of Canada references the new CAN/ULC S1001 requirements for "Integrated Systems Testing". While drawing on personal experiences, from working group developments and international commissioning projects, this presentation will provide fundamental knowledge on life safety commissioning and integrated testing.
